The days of shearing and stamping have been replaced with fine blank stamping, which makes infinitely superior, more accurate components required for Gerber folding knives. We have arrived at the threshold of the 21 st century. And Gerber leads the industry.

Such a reputation is no accident. I'll never forget my father telling me, "There's always someone who will make it cheaper and sell it for less. But they probably won't be around tomorrow!"
