# Colonel Rex Applegate (1914-1998)

The Multi-Tool Museum



With sorrow we must note the passing of a friend and colleague, Colonel Rex Applegate. He passed away July 14, 1998 while attending a law enforcement conference in San Diego, California. It was an honor to work with him, and an even greater pleasure to know him.

REX APPLEGATE had a life that reads more like an adventure novel than a conventional biography. He was the patriarch of one of the oldest and most significant families in the early history of his home state of Oregon. His uncle by marriage was the famous Remington exhibition shooter, Gus Peret. From him he learned to hunt and shoot and received advanced firearms training at an early age.

JUST BEFORE WWII he graduated from the University of Oregon and its ROTC program and entered the Army as a reserve officer in the Military Police. He competed with 10,000 other reserve officers for 100 regular Army commissions and came out 11th from the top. This led to his being selected as one of the first people assigned to the Office of Strategic Services (OSS) headed up by COL "Wild Bill"

Donovan. Donovan personally tasked Applegate to "learn all there was to know about close combat with and without weapons" with the idea of setting up a facility to train future OSS field operatives.

APPLEGATE WAS the right person at the right place and time. He found and set up the OSS training site, called Area B, at what is now the presidential retreat Camp David. He went to England and learned as much as possible from the British Commandos and SOE. He even went on Commando raids against the Germans. During this period he worked closely with W. E. Fairbairn and E.A.

Sykes, co-designers of the famous Fairbairn-Sykes British Commando knife. These former Shanghai policemen were the allies' top experts on close quarters combat.

APPLEGATE SET UP the OSS close combat training along with the help of Fairbairn who was on loan to the U.S. as an instructor. For six weeks during this period Applegate was tasked with being the personal bodyguard of President Roosevelt when he was at the lodge near area B where he met with Churchill and other dignitaries. Applegate and Fairbairn collaborated on improved versions of both the F-S Commando knife and the Smatchet. Years later these were introduced commercially as the Applegate-Fairbairn Combat Knife and the Applegate-Fairbairn Combat Smatchet. These in turn led Applegate to recently introduce miniature versions of both knives, for use as concealment or boot knives, and a folding version of the A-F Combat knife which is being made by Gerber as the A-F Combat Folder.

IN 1942 APPLEGATE was transferred to the Military Intelligence Center at Camp Ritchie, Maryland where he became the chief instructor for close quarters combat. Under his instruction and with feedback from field operatives, modern close quarters combat training reached a pinnacle not achieved since then.

HE AUTHORED several books that have become standard references in their field including Kill Or Get Killed, Scouting and Patrolling, and Riot Control. Working in Latin America in the post-WWII period Applegate became the world's leading authority on riot control. He was even appointed as a brevet general in the Mexican Army for a short period. He was also an early proponent of such non-lethal weapons as Mace, the riot baton, and pepper spray and such lethal innovations as the Glaser prefragmented handgun bullet. He was directly responsible for S&W's introduction of the internal hammer Centennial revolver series. He has authored numerous articles on a wide range of topics in firearms, law enforcement, and military journals. Applegate has also produced a variety of video tapes on exhibition shooters and point shooting. His video Shooting For Keeps has become a best seller for training in close quarters combat shooting. Even though he was well into his eighties, one of the most respectable qualities of the Colonel was that he remained active in his field of expertise. He continued to travel the country as a consultant on firearms training, riot control, and as an outspoken proponent of point shooting.

IN RECENT YEARS Applegate was honored by being selected to the Blade Magazine Cutlery Hall of Fame and also as a recipient of the 1996 Outstanding American Handgunner Award. He has also been a devout defender of the 2nd Amendment and has served as a member of the NRA Board of Directors.

COL REX APPLEGATE is a unique American treasure.

Colonel Applegate is survived by his wife Carole, two daughters, eight grandchildren and one greatgrandchild, to whom we offer our deepest condolences.







# Sharpening & Warranties

# Sharpening

What Type of Sharpener is Required: There are many good sharpeners on the market today. The main factor in sharpening is the device you use to remove the material from the blade must maintain a uniform angle for you and not allow your efforts from stroke to stroke to change the angle of pressure you are putting on the cutting surface of the blade. If this angle relationship is changing from stroke to stroke, you will end up with a rounded edge that will feel sharp for a short period of time and dull rapidly.

There are three styles of systems on the market that Gerber® recommends:

- 1. One that holds the knife stationary and controls the abrasive angle that you achieve against the blade with a guide rod.
- 2. The second system has the abrasive sitting horizontal on a flat surface and the blade is clamped into a device that sets the angle that the blade touches the surface of the stone.
- 3. The final system is the easiest to use and Gerber® feels that it is the most flexible related to sharpening almost anything that needs sharpening. This unit places the abrasive (two v-shaped rods or preferably triangles) in a vertical format with the knife blade being stroked downward over these rods. The angle is not maintained as precisely as the other two systems, but the technique is easily mastered and the ease of operation and simplicity make it Gerber's recommendation.

None of these systems require a high level of skill to master and with a little patience and practice you will be putting a factory edge on your cutlery in no time.

**Edge Angle:** The angle of the edge recommended for Gerber® knives is a 30 degree included angle, with 15 degrees per side for both a concave or hollow grind (see inset). This angle will provide a good working edge that will be sharp and durable at the same time. The sharpening systems mentioned above will instruct you as to how to set and maintain this angle while utilizing your sharpener.

# Quality and Innovation Explained

#### ATS-34 Stainless Steel

The use of ATS-34 stainless steel is the result of extensive research by our engineering and operations team. Until now, this high performance blade steel has been used primarily by custom knife makers. Our comprehensive research has resulted in mastering the techniques that bring about the best in the material and allows us to produce the finest quality product at a reasonable price.

With our special heat treating and tempering techniques, we can harden ATS-34 stainless steel to Rc 59-61 (Rc is the Rockwell C scale of hardness that is the standard comparison for knife steels). At this hardness, the blade is very tough and shows no signs of being brittle. This also gives the blade a longer edge life, therefore, less sharpening is required. It is a very expensive material and is more difficult to process, but blades produced from this material are truly superior.

Although this blade is "stainless steel," it must be cared for more frequently than conventional stainless steels because of its higher carbon content. To prevent corrosion and rust, the blade must be wiped clean after each use to remove contaminants - especially around salt water. A light coating of oil must be applied after cleaning to ensure proper life expectancy. The blade can be re-sharpened with conventional diamond or ceramic sharpeners, just like our standard 440 series blades. We recommend an edge angle of 30° included, with 15° per side. See back of catalog for sharpening techniques.

#### Handle Material

In many cases, the handle is the most important feature of the knife; if it doesn't feel right, you won't use it. When picking up a knife for the first time, it must fit into your hand like an extension of your arm. Kraton® and Santoprene® are two of the most popular handle materials today due to comfort and security. The nonslip feel and shock absorbing characteristics lend to better knife control in all weather conditions; cold and wet or dry and hot. Your hand naturally wraps around the handle in any position to give you the best control in any situation.

Gerber® has pioneered many manufacturing techniques with utility and design patents. The Gator® and Fillet handles are completely coated in the rubbery material for the most functional grip, especially in wet

conditions. The E-Z-Out<sup>TM</sup> and Sport Saw have the material positioned ergonomically to provide maximum comfort. These compounds are either permanently molded or bonded with the strongest adhesive for a lifetime of use.

#### SAF.T.PLUS™ System

The SAF.T.PLUS™ System provides a new way of locking components in place on multi-purpose tools. It is a group of different but interrelated systems working together.

Wedge and Tang Design: Every component has a special tang that is identical and provides a secure fit to the spring loaded wedge. This Wedge and Tang Design helps resist fold over when each tool is extended completely out and also helps prevent secured components from rotating out. Rotating a component will lodge the wedge under the tang of the tool. This locks the component tight until the wedge is manually pulled back using the safety release button. The Wedge and Tang Design is central to the SAF.T.PLUS<sup>TM</sup> System. Patent Pending

**Axle Rod:** The Axle component is a stainless steel rod designed for strength and versatility. By incorporating a removable smooth rod, the tool components housed in the handles can be replaced or repaired efficiently and effectively. The user can change side pressure by adjusting end screw if tool pack is too tight or loose. This smooth rod also enables Gerber Legendary Blades® to design a virtually unlimited combination of tool systems for Gerber's current and future multi-purpose tool line. *Patent Pending* 

Independent Tool Rotation System: To prevent rotating out more than one tool at a time, stainless steel Anti-Rotation washers were placed between each tool. This enables one tool to be pulled out without affecting other tools because there is no contact between the tools—contact is only between the washers and the tools. Patent Pending


